Republican State Auditor candidate supports abortion ban after six weeks

"Health and human services are a significant part of local government budgets, so we need an auditor who understands that healthcare includes abortion under Minnesota law. An auditor, with views like my opponent, pushing an anti-abortion agenda could disrupt local access to reproductive care, particularly for low-income Minnesotans." - State Auditor Julie Blaha.

ST. PAUL, Minn. — Republican state auditor candidate Ryan Wilson supports a ban on abortion around six weeks, according to a Minnesota Family Council (MFC) questionnaire.

The questionnaire asked candidates nine questions; for example, if they support a ban on abortion around six weeks and oppose all taxpayer funding of abortion.

Wilson was the *only* statewide candidate to directly answer yes to every question, without any qualification, according to the response legend. The MFC recently <u>removed</u> the questionnaire from their website; however, the <u>link</u> was recovered.

While all of Wilson's answers are problematic, his anti-abortion stances can have a particular impact on the state auditor's office.
